Plans: Meet with Blue Quills College Administration at the beginning of March to develop a strategy to assist us in achieving this goal; to learn how to apply learnings to practice. Better understanding around what is appropriate for non-Indigenous persons (in house program staff) to initiate in terms of conversation and culturally based activities.

Activities: LPLN Management are committed to travelling to Blue Quills regularly for learning and strategizing. Will include guest speakers to provide storytelling or culturally based activities/games/crafts, purchase of art related supplies or of relevant musical instruments and/or related type items.

Resources: Blue Quills College

 Provide additional PLC core programming and services using Indigenous culturally-based practise and direct implementation of Indigenous knowledge and traditions **Plans:** Development of a plan for engagement. Willingness to incorporate additional programs to our current baseline of programs either on our own or in partnership with other Indigenous based organization staff.

Activities: Have local Indigenous/Metis leaders come in to tell stories and craft/sing with families. (I.e. Friendship Centre staff come in to teach families about the meaning of dream catchers and then give attendees the opportunity to make one for themselves, implementation of teepee teachings as another tool to compliment the work many of us are already striving to achieve in terms of incorporation of character education).

Resources: Indigenous guest speakers and others highly respected in their field of trauma/addictions/parenting after trauma etc. (i.e. Dr. Gabor Mate), local Indigenous or Metis community leaders. Purchase of

	artwork and a variety of implements to create a more welcoming space in each of our centres. Staff will be expected to participate in all trainings or community events which our centres host or are available during their regular work schedule. Those events outside our regular work hours will be encouraged as well.
Provide outreach activities and services to engage, network and connect with Indigenous families	Plans: Meet with community leaders in each of our First Nation and Metis Settlements Activities: Discuss needs/venues/community support, develop contact list of community liaisons and co facilitators. Resources: Existing skill set of Parent Link staff, community gathering spaces, food, and vehicle.

Engage in relationship building activities with Indigenous serving organizations, partners or First Nations communities	Plans: Existing partnerships each of our sites already have with organizations such as Native Counselling Services, Native Friendship Centres, Maternal Child Health programs in our First Nations communities, Healthy Babies programs, AHS, Jordan's Principal team leads working in our communities etc. will be expanded. Enhanced understanding of what relationship building activities will look and feel like in terms of meeting spaces, dress, personal conduct etc. Activities: Invite them to our Parent Link Celebrations, invite them to co facilitate groups or activities with us; welcome the opportunities to take part in each of our First nations/Metis communities existing Interagency/Parenting groups as a tool to expand our network of acquaintances and resources and also to promote the partnerships being built. Resources: FCSS staff vehicle, or mileage costs
