STAFF REPORT

Title: Ardmore 4-H Beef Club - Resolution Amendment

Meeting Date: June 14, 2022

Executive Summary:

At Council's meeting of May 24, 2022, Council authorized Mayor Copeland to purchase a beef, up to a \$5,000.00 limit (Resolution No. CRM20220524.1017) at the Ardmore 4-H Beef Club fundraising auction.

Attached is the Livestock Purchase Agreement in the amount of \$5,938.50.

Council will need to amend Resolution No. CRM20220524.1027 for an additional \$3,000.00 towards the purchase of a beef at the Ardmore 4-H Beef Club fundraising auction that was held on May 29, 2022 at the Cold Lake Agricultural Exhibition Grounds. This additional funding would also be used towards the processing of the beef.

Background:

His Worship Mayor Copeland sought permission from City Council to donate funding to the Ardmore 4-H Beef Club during their show and sale that was to be held on May 29, 2022 at the Cold Lake Agricultural Exhibition Grounds.

At Council's meeting of May 24, 2022, Council authorized Mayor Copeland to purchase a beef, up to a \$5,000.00 limit (Resolution No. CRM20220524.1017). The purchase of a cow at the event ultimately totaled \$5,938.50 and there are processing costs to consider.
