Title: Chief Administrative Officer's Monthly Report - May 2022

## **Executive Summary:**

This report is intended to provide an update to Council on the activities and projects being conducted by Administration.

## **General Discussion**

The City of Cold Lake has moved forward on various strategic priorities of Council. The following provides a summary based on the Council's adopted priorities:

The following are updates on Council strategic priorities:

### PILT Dispute Resolution

 The federal tribunal completed its hearing. The City of Cold Lake is now awaiting a decision. It is hoped that the decision will be available this late spring/early summer. In fact, administration is hoping to see a decision by the end of June, 2022. There is little more administration can do as the process now is, for the most part, in the hands of the tribunal.



## Lakeshore Drive Implementation

 After significant research relating to the erosion control for the proposed linear parkway, administration provided Council a briefing on the updates to the implementation of the improvements to Lakeshore Drive during Council's Corporate Priorities Committee meeting of April 19, 2022.

The project is currently being tendered for pricing and a public open house has been tentatively scheduled for June 23, 2022.

## Aquatic Facility: Concept Development and Feasibility

 City Council held a workshop on April 27, 2022 to receive an update to the community and stakeholder consultations and well as various design elements being considered for the project.

Based on the above feedback and the mechanical system being proposed for the facility, administration will be touring Wood Buffalo's Macdonald Island Facility between June 15 and 17, 2022.

## Taxi Bylaw Review

 Council will have a non-statutory public hearing to the proposed amendments to the taxi bylaw at their June 14, 2022 meeting and consider 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd reading to the bylaw.

## Medical Clinic/Services Options

 A meeting was been scheduled with Ms. Verna Yiu, President and CEO of Alberta Health Services (AHS) on March 31, 2022; however, Ms. Yiu was released of her position. AHS has not provided any further feedback on times for a rescheduled meeting with the incoming CEO.

### Homeless/Vulnerable Population Forum/Terms of Reference

 A proposed alternative relating to Homeless will present itself to City Council in the coming weeks. It is understood that a Municipal Planning Commission was tentatively scheduled however this had to be delated due to seeking confirmation on direction from the Cold Lake John Howard Society.



## **Municipal Census**

 Due to the shortage of finding support workers for the municipal census, a significant effort was made with City staff through the month of June, 2022. The Municipal Census should be wrapping in the coming weeks.

## Cold Lake Regional Airport Expansion Options

 The City of Cold Lake has developed a draft terms of reference for engineering relating to the Cold Lake Regional Airport Expansion Options. It is anticipated that Request for Proposals will be issued in the coming weeks.

## Highway 28 Concerns

 On June 7, 2022, His Worship Mayor Copeland and other regional partnership held a meeting with the Minister of Transportation relating to Highway 28 concerns. The regional partners were given an opportunity to educate the Minister of the deterring and condition of the Highway and concerns relating to public safety.
