4. Location Details:
We have signed on to offer this SMARTstart program for the next 3 years. This year we will host this program in the City of Cold Lake at various venues.
5. Who is the targeted audience, and how many individuals will attend this event: SMARTstart is a community Business support program that involves many different stakeholders from new businesses, established businesses, Chambers of Commerce, Municipalities, Provincial Organizations, Banks, NonProfits. We expect to have 5-10 entrepreneurs complete the program in the first year however, there is a large community network being created to support them.
6. Identify all funding requests or arrangements connected to this event: We currently have a commitment from the East Central Regional Innovation Network (ECARIN) to be a Title Sponsor of \$5000 for the duration of the 3 years we will run this program. We feel that as this year we are hosting this project in the City of Cold Lake, that this would be a good fit for the City of Cold Lake to partner as Seminar Sponsor to support 4 of the 11 workshops for a total of \$4000.
We also have many local businesses and business owners committed to either providing sponsorship, workshops or to partner as mentors to the younger businesses. We have partnered with Business Link, BDC and Futurpreneur to offer resources and provide presentations. As well, the Cold Lake and the Bonnyville Chambers of Commerce and the Economic Development officers from the Town of Bonnyville and the MD of Bonnyville are collaborating for the success of this project.
7. How do you feel this event supports recreation, art, culture and heritage within the community: The SMARTstart program will enhance the City as It brings together businesses, organizations, provincial and municipal governments to work together to better our region. By supporting business programs such as this, the City has the opportunity to provide real assistance to our small businesses to start or to grow. The truth is that only 35% of business start ups will survive past the first 5 years however, studies show that with education and support, 80-90% of these businesses will succeed beyond 5 years. Our goal as the business support agency in the Lakeland is to collaborate with our regional partners to provide real programs that will promote economic development and job growth. The SMARTstart program is the vehicle to drive our small business economy.

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



RE: SMARTstart Program 2022

Community Futures Lakeland is a federally funded nonprofit organization that serves the Lakeland region from the City of Cold Lake, the MD of Bonnyville, the Town of Bonnyville, 2 Metis Settlements, 3 First Nations and all of the communities in between. We serve our rural business communities in three ways:

- 1) offering loans to our businesses, 2) offering free business training, coaching and resources and
- 3) economic development through partnerships, programs and events.

When we look at our rural small business communities, we see an urgent need to serve our new businesses who require support to be able to sustain past the first 5 years in business. The harsh reality is that many local small businesses struggle to get started and find it challenging to make it past their first 3-5 years. Canadian studies show that only 35% of new businesses survive those first crucial years.

There is hope! Statistics also show that business owners with education in entrepreneurship have an 80-90% chance of success with a new business. That's why SMARTstart was developed – to increase business' odds of success.

Community Futures Lakeland has taken on the SMARTstart program to address the issues of rural business retention and expansion. In our rural areas, it can be difficult for a small business to access the resources necessary to survive the economic downturns and struggles of staffing. Not every entrepreneur has the essential skills required to weather the economic cycles. The SMARTstart program consists of three main components: 1) GoForth's Essential Small Business Skills online training, 2) In-Person Workshops/Sessions that cover essential topics ranging from taxation to branding to insurance, 3) Mentorship – Participants will be paired with another local, experienced business owner that will guide them through the business plan development process.

This program hinges on the partnership and sponsorship of our regional communities and organizations. We have a partnership commitment from both the Cold Lake Regional Chamber of Commerce and the Bonnyville & District Chamber of Commerce as well as the Economic Development Officers for the Town of Bonnyville and the MD of Bonnyville. We have brought in local businesses to participate, mentor, sponsor and offer workshop presentations. We have included our East Central Regional Innovation Network as a Title Sponsor to begin to showcase some of the upcoming programs they have to offer our Lakeland businesses. We have also reached out to all three of our Municipalities to offer an opportunity to sponsor this exciting initiative.

The program outcome will see the participants submit a final business plan, feasibility study or strategic plan. The economic impact of the SMARTstart program in the Lakeland will be the retention of our small businesses by creating supportive cohorts and networks where the business' needs are being met. The goal is that we will retain these businesses and assist in their expansion. The logical outcome will be greater growth and job creation.

SMARTstart is an 8-month program that will begin mid-October 2022. It includes opening and closing events with 11 training workshops/sessions. We will run the program in the City of Cold Lake this first year.
