SECTION 2: APPLICATION INFORMATION

Founded in 1979, Kinosoo Performing Arts Association (KPAA) is a non-profit Alberta registered society established in Cold Lake. The association is run by ten volunteer board members and they dedicate hundreds of hours a year to bring in excellent entertainment to the City of Cold Lake.

This year the association is celebrating their 43rd season in bringing world class professional entertainers to Cold Lake. We present four or five shows a year at the banquet room in the Lakeland Inn. KPAA are great supporters of our local business community and are the longest standing arts presenting group in Cold Lake.

We receive some funding from local sponsors, however the task of getting sponsors has been more challenging because of the Pandemic and the numerous other organizations tapping into the local business community for funds. KPAA gets some grant funding from the Alberta Foundation of the Arts, however the funding is dependent on having show performances. Almost a two year period of no shows, with expenses associated with rebooking has had a financial impact on KPAA.

Show Budgeting

On average booking an artist usually cost \$3500-\$6000 per show. Additional costs are advertising \$350 (newspaper, posters), sound technician \$700, Depending on the number of people requiring, hotel rooms there is additional hotel and meal costs for the band and the sound technicians. Other annual cost include attending Show Case (to pick artists) insurance, administrative costs and registry costs. With having 4-5 shows a year the contribution to the local business community is substantial.

Kinosoo Performing Arts is requesting \$5000 under the criteria of the City of Cold Lake Goodwill criteria to assist our Arts Association in increasing the quality of life in the City of Cold Lake.
