1. Describe the ask for support (attach additional pages if required):

The Wild North Eclectic Society is a non-profit organization that was founded to promote live music within our city for both music lovers and musicians alike. In July of 2021 we organized the inaugural Summer Rush festival that provided an opportunity for 20 local musicians to play in front of an audience of 100 people. Building upon that success, we are now expanding our capacity to 400 attendees and, on top of promoting local original acts, are bringing in touring acts from Edmonton; a costly yet necessary endeavor to both grow our festival and ensure its future success. Therefore, the Wild North Eclectic Society is requesting that, as a gesture of goodwill, the City Council grant us \$8,000 that will cover the costs of the musical talent for the duration of the festival (see attached band contracts) as our 2021 event only generated \$1,000 in revenue and cannot cover the costs of the bands without going into debt, which will seriously inhibit our ability to run this festival in the future.

4. Location:

The Summer Rush Festival is conveniently located at 63115a RR 415A, just 5 minutes from Cold Lake North and South, on a stunning 5 acre property on the shores of Long Bay.

5. Who is the targeted audience, and how many individuals will attend this event:

The Summer Rush Festival is an all ages event that has something for everyone: live country, rock, folk, punk and electronic music for music lovers; food trucks for food lovers, craft beer and spirits for beverage lovers, and a farmer's market for people who love to shop local.

6. Identify all funding requests or arrangements connected to this event:

Thus far, the Wild North Eclectic Society has received \$5,000 from the MD of Bonnyville, in the form of their Community Action Grant. This money is allocated for First Aid and supplies, security services, and materials such as square debit card readers, volunteer shirts and the purchase of alcohol. As well, Nails Ent. has donated \$250 to cover building supplies for the stage.

7. How do you feel this event supports recreation, art, culture and heritage within the community:

The Wild North Eclectic Society is astutely aware of the vital importance of community events and how it fosters cohesiveness within our community. The Summer Rush festival is such a place for people to come together to enjoy our multifaceted event: the natural beauty of Long Bay, the talent of local musicians and popular bands across many genres, cultural food offered from the food trucks, and artisanal items in the farmers market that reflect our heritage. Furthermore, we feel that this event greatly supports Cold Lake's tourism and hospitality industries as many of our artists and their fans are coming from out of town and will be financially contributing to many of the amenities that Cold Lake has to offer.

8. How do you intend to acknowledge the City of Cold Lake and Committee as a sponsor:

Should this grant be successful, we plan on using our social media platforms to thank the city, as well as posting provided signage at the event. The City's logo will also be placed on the brochure that gets handed out to all guests, and the City's contributions will also be frequently mentioned in the emcee announcements between acts.

9. Provide details on any locally sourced items, resources, or services:

The success of the Summer Rush festival is ensured by both a culmination of countless hours by dedicated and passionate volunteers and participation with many local vendors including: beverages from Cold Lake Brewing and Journey North, and food from Joly's Fine Cuisine. As well, sanitation services have been arranged with Bob's Portables, and all accommodations are taking place at Hotel Dene. Several businesses have also donated gift certificates for the bands, these include: Wicked Water Sports, Emma's Cafe, and Beantrees Cafe. Lastly, the sound and lighting production for this event is being provided, free of charge, by local production company Earlwood Music and Audio.







License to Conduct a Concert - Bylaw No. 808 63113A, 63113B, 63115A Range Road 415A

Please be advised that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) at the June 22, 2022 Regular Council Meeting approved a Concert License for the August 12-14, 2022 Summer Rush Music Festival, subject to the following conditions:

- The Concert shall be conducted in accordance with all provisions of Bylaw 808 and the supporting documents for the license application and the following:
 - a. Event admission is limited to 400 general tickets and 100 "other" attendees (i.e. artists, volunteers, and vendors).
- 2. Wild North Eclectic Society shall indemnify and save harmless the M.D. from and against any and all liability whatsoever resulting from injury or death or damage to any person, persons or property of or as a result of the operation of the concert and shall carry a minimum of \$1,000,000 Public Liability Insurance for the event and shall provide proof of said insurance naming the M.D. co-insured.
- 3. This License is non-assignable and is valid for the period 1:00 p.m., August 12, 2022 to 11:00 a.m. August 14, 2022.
- 4. Quiet times are between 1 a.m. to 7 a.m. August 13 and August 14, 2022 as per the Council Meeting presentation.
