

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Describe the ask for support:

The Cold Lake Filipino Basketball League, a non-profit organization will be having a 2-day basketball invitational tournament on August 05 & 06, 2023 at the JJParr Sport Center.

This tourney will be participated by at least 8 teams, 2 teams from Edmonton, Calgary, Red Deer, Lloydminster, Lacla Biche, Bonnyville and Cold Lake. Teams will be playing basketball for 2 days and only 1 team will reign as Champion.

As a non-profit organization with limited financial resources we won't be able to host this kind of event without the local government financial support.

This is our third time seeking for financial support from the City government of Cold Lake. Second time for Community Incentive Grant. We are hoping we will get approved as per amount requested.

Describe the targeted audience, expected attendance, or membership:

Basketball enthusiasts in Lakeland area, neighboring cities and towns together with their families and friends will gather to witness this annual event where you can see competitive basketball games of elite players coming from all over Alberta and to give entertainment as well. Estimated attendees are 300-400 people.

Describe how these funds will develop or enhance recreation, art, culture and heritage within the community:

Basketball is a big part of Filipino culture and through this sport we are able to make our community becomes stronger, better as we integrate into our community. Organizing this kind of event our community becomes active and spearheaded in encouraging youths, and others to participate in our tournaments as much as possible.

Identify all other fundraising strategies and requests:

Prior to the tournament as big as this, we already start talking to some private individuals, local businesses and the like about the possibilities of helping us financially or in kind. Based on our experienced getting financial support from people and local businesses is tough. Most of them limited to giving gift certificates and discount cards which is also a big help to the organizing committee and our participating teams. We also asked our members to donate empty bottles as much as they can to raise the fund needed.

Describe how you will acknowledge the City of Cold Lake as a sponsor:

The CFBL will award a plaque of appreciation to the city government of Cold Lake during the opening ceremony through Mayor Craig Copeland as he will be our guest of honor during this annual event. It will be featured in our Facebook page prior, during and after the tournament. Also be mentioned during the tournament that the tournament is not possible without the support coming from the city government of Cold Lake.

Teams coming from Calgary, Red Deer, Edmonton, Saskatchewan, Lloydminster will be staying in hotels for 2 nights, patronizing our local restaurants and stores for their needs during the event like bottled water, energy drinks, basketball supplies, etc. All the supplies for this tournament will be purchased locally such as whistle, pens, markers, tapes, bond papers, ink, snacks, lunch for 2 days, bottled water, pops, energy drinks, basketballs if available, trophies and medals if available. Two referees are coming from Bonnyville as well.

On behalf of the Cold Lake Filipino Basketball League CFBL, I as the President of the organization extend our utmost gratitude to the City of Cold Lake for granting us the support through the Community Event Incentive Grant.

The Cold Lake Filipino Basketball League is a non-profit organization established in 2018 with the purpose of building a stronger Filipino and Canadian community through playing basketball. Since arriving here in Cold Lake in 2009, the first thing I asked to my employer is where I can play basketball, he mentioned about JJParr in military base, after a couple of months I meet some Filipinos and we started playing pick up games. Fast forward in 2018 we decided to form an organization so that we can organize a basketball tournament and slowly make Cold Lake to be well known for organizing basketball tournaments. In 2019 we organized our first 2-day basketball invitational tournament, we invited teams from Edmonton, Red Deer, Saskatchewan, Lacla Biche, Bonnyville and Cold Lake. It was a successful event and we decided to make it an annual event.

Mayor Craig Copeland helped us and introduced us to different people in charge on committees to guide us to the process of getting grant. It was Terra Dimion who encourage us to apply for Community Event Incentive Grant as this was suitable to the event we are organizing.

The concluded 2-day basketball tournament we hosted last October 22 & 23, 2022 at the Cold Lake High School which was attended by Mayor Craig Copeland was a huge success. Basketball fanatics came out to watch the games. Teams are exciting to comeback to this year's event and some other teams who didn't make it last year also express interest to participate this year.

The CFBL will be hosting its annual 2-day invitational basketball tournament on August 05 & 06 2023. This tourney will be participated by at least 8 teams coming from Calgary, Red Deer, 2 teams from Edmonton and Lloydminster, Saskatchewan, Lacla Biche, Bonnyville, and Cold Lake.

Terra Dimion emailed me about the possibility of adding our request to the City Council Agenda for the meeting next week because I mentioned in my Recreation and Cultural Grant Funding Reform Form about CFBL suggestion to forge an agreement between CFBL and the City government of Cold Lake so that we can get the full maximum amount of \$10,000.00 for our annual basketball event without going to the process of reapplying every year which sometime don't match our calendar year of events.

CFBL is planning to host two big tournaments this year, one in May and August. With the same concept of 2-day invitational basketball tournament but different skill level and participants.


May 2-day invitational basketball tournament is for basketball enthusiasts in Lakeland community areas that includes Lloydminster, St. Paul, Vegreville, Bonnyville, Lac La Biche, Athabasca, and Cold Lake. We are inviting 8 teams for this tournament.

August 2-day invitational basketball tournament is a highly skilled level of competition, where you can witness elite basketball players from all over Alberta coming to Cold Lake for a 2-day nonstop basketball vying for the trophy, medals and cash prize. Team participants are representing their city, so this is a battle of pride and honor, teams are also sponsored by big companies like Crosstown, Insurance company, and other businesses. That means they also invested huge amount of money to form a competitive team to compete on this prestigious event.

If the city government is willing to support these 2 big events, it would be a big help to our community and our organization. This is our way of promoting Cold Lake to neighboring cities and towns by bringing these elite teams to Cold Lake to play basketball, to give entertainment, at the same time for the guests to experience and see how beautiful Cold Lake is, and how hospitable we are.

Lastly, CFBL are very thankful to the city government of Cold Lake for the continued support to our community.
