The purpose of the **Cold Lake Music Festival** is to promote performance and education in amateur arts and culture in the Cold Lake area. We are the only music festival in a 160 km area. We provide an opportunity for music and speech students with private teachers or within the school system to participate in a regional Festival that is part of the Provincial Music Festival Association. Children (90%) and adults (10%) perform for their peers and professional adjudicators from outside the region who do a constructive critique of all performances. A positive learning experience for everyone is the result.


The **Cold Lake Music Festival** is held for 2 weeks every spring with sessions in the daytime and evening, all of which are open to the public. Since 1987, seniors, home schoolers and music lovers come to sessions for some entertainment and education. Admission to festival is by free-will donation at the door. Classes include Piano, Vocal, Speech Arts, Band, Choir, Instrumental, and Musical Theatre. Some participants continue to the Provincial Festival. The last few years have seen more participation than ever before. A final concert is held at the end of Festival. Our community has supported festival for over 30 years. Our festival is educational, musical, arts, cultural, and preventative in nature.

The **Cold Lake Music Festival** operates as a registered charitable society with a volunteer board. During Festival, many volunteers give their time to help with administration, moving of furniture, admissions table, etc. Entry fees raise about \$2,000 each year. The remaining funds come in the form of donations from local businesses, service clubs, corporations and individuals who sponsor parts of the Festival. We pay dues to the Provincial and National Music Festivals, approximately \$700 per year. Our financial obligations include dues, adjudicator fees, mileage and hotel expenses for adjudicators, venue costs, piano tuning, supplies such as certificates and medals, printing of programs, adjudicator forms, advertising.

Many great Canadian musicians began their careers at the local festival level. Glen Gould, Shania Twain, Liona Boyd, and Angela Hewitt are just a few. As an example, Angela Hewitt is a pianist from Ottawa who, as a result of success at the Ottawa, Ontario and National music festivals, was invited to an international Baroque music competition, which she won. This jumpstarted her concert piano career.

Students spend many hours in practice. Youth who have avid interests are more likely to stay on the "straight and narrow", and not pursue less desirable activities. Achievement fosters pride, and a likelihood of future success. Our festival provides goals and measurable progress for students. Students learn much about working together to achieve a common goal. They gain a real sense of community amongst themselves, as well as with their audience. Many of our festival's participants go on to study music in university. A few now work as music teachers in our schools and community.
