SECTION 2: PROCLAMATION REQUIREMENTS

- 2. The cause is one of benefit and/or interest to the majority of the citizens of the City of Cold Lake
- 3. The cause is an initiative of the City of Cold Lake

The Office of the Mayor requires 4 weeks to review and process all proclamation requests.
