Age Friendly Cold Lake (AFCL) has steadily grown in its reach and impact since we started in 2019. We currently operate with provincial and federal grants as well as corporate donations to the annual Ice Fishing Tournament. We are working on developing partnership strategies with other local non profits and creating a social enterprise to further sustain our ongoing program development.

Describe the Project:  AFCL and the Cold Lake Men's Shed are currently co-located in an industrial bay next door to Urlacher Construction. The Shed takes up the majority of the space with offices in the front portion only. The owner of the building, Rupert Urlacher (EKD Enterprises), has offered to cover the cost of developing a mezzanine floor for expanded gathering and office space which will need to be accessed by an elevator to the upper level space. AFCL is responsible for funding the elevator portion of the development.		
Potential Impact the Project is expected to have on the community:  (You may wish to include: the demographics of the community who will be served by the project; the number of community members who may potentially benefit from the project; the level of community support for the project; the potential longevity of the project; how the project will benefit the community.)  Our facility is home to the Cold Lake Men's Shed. There is a current meeting space that was intended for their members to use for social gathering, that is only accessible by steep stairs which they are not able to use due to the physical limitations associated with aging and illness. Additionally, AFCL has a lending library of dementia-related resources that no longer fit in the main floor office area. Public access to the second level development would increase access to important resources needed for family support. Our ability to meet confidentially with seniors in need of support is also unavailable without access to the potential second floor development being completed by Mr. Urlacher. AFCL is faced with the need to move to a new location that we cannot afford that will provide us with needed space or partner with Mr. Urlacher in the development of the proposed space.
